Dear Executive Committee Members:

A “Special Called Meeting” will be held Thursday, August 21 at 6 p.m. at the I.B.E.W. Local 1870, 3030 Madison. The purpose of this meeting is to approve the proposed process that will be used to fill Judicial-Elect Jim Kyle’s Senate District 30 seat. Please note the time is different from our regularly scheduled meeting because this is a “Called Meeting.”

A Call for Candidates who are interested in applying for the Senate District 30 vacancy will go out Monday, August 18, 2014. The deadline for those interested in applying is Friday, August 22, 2014 at noon.

Per State Statue, Executive Committee members who reside in Senate District 30 and House District Chairs representing Districts that overlap with District 30 will make up the Caucus that will be responsible for electing a person to fill the Senate District 30 vacancy. The Senate District 30 Caucus will be guided by State Party Chair Roy Herron and Chaired by Shelby County Election Commissioner/SCDP Committeewoman Norma Lester. A draft of the process is attached for your review.
